Audit

An audit is a process of sequential transferring of <u>audit packages</u> from an <u>SDC</u> to the TIMS system and handling the response generated by the system for the specific taxpayer's <u>secure element</u>.

There are two common scenarios:

- <u>Remote Audit</u>
- Local Audit


and two specific ones:

- Scanning the QR code on an invoice (performed by customers of tax auditors)
- Secure Element Audit (performed by tax auditors)

An audit is always an asynchronous process. Depending on the amount of data and means of communication, it can take from less than a second to a couple of hours.

Once audit is completed, TIMS will generate and deliver a <u>Proof of Audit</u> for a specific <u>Secure Element</u>. If the Proof of Audit is valid, the Secure element will reset the limit imposed during the personalization process.
